We have the honor to welcome You to the NAC meetings and Open Day in Helsinki, Finland on the 28th– 30th September. The Open Day Seminar on Friday the 29th of September is open to everybody.

NAC Open Day theme: Current Phenomena in Intercountry Adoptions

The main focus of the Open Day meeting will be on the role of social media in adoptions.

One of the leading social media experts in Finland, **Katleena Korteso**, will tell us how the adopted children can find a safe place in social media. In addition, we will hear testimonies from adult adoptees about how social media has affected them. **Jeannette Wollenstein & Juliette Duchesne** from ISS will give a presentation about social media in the search of origin and **Finnish adoption organisations** share experiences of internet-based support.

Medical Doctors **Helena Lapinleimu** and **Hanna Raaska** will come and share insights and interesting results from the Finnish Adoption Study (FinAdo). FinAdo (www.finado.fi) is the most extensive adoption study conducted in Finland. These results will give us ideas to improve adoption practices and support adoptees and their families in the future.

Finally, Principal Legal Officer **Laura Martinez-Mora** will present us current issues from HccH Permanent Bureau.

How to get to the hotel from the airport

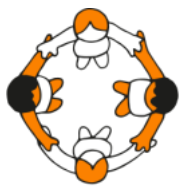
